Dear year 6 parent/carer,

As part of the Government's vision to run catch up activities for children over the summer holidays, at Hassenbrook Academy we will be running a series of summer schools targeted at year 6 pupils who will be joining us as Year 7s in September.

The first week, week commencing 26.7.2021, will be focussing on literacy, numeracy, creativity and a lot of cooking! We are targeting this week towards those pupils who feel they might like some more transition time with us before September so that they feel more confident about the new academic year. **Please sign up below.**

Also week beginning the 26.7.2021 AND week beginning 2.8.2021 we will be running the Junior Passport to Adventure. Junior P2A aims to provide our younger students with the opportunity to explore the outdoors as a means of developing life tools for wellness and empathetic awareness to others. JP2A encourages our children to try new things, ensuring our students feel comfortable in any environment. This is a one week course where our younger students have the opportunity to explore map reading, cooking on Trangia stoves, learning a new skill, team building, leadership skills and gaining a love of the outdoors. This will prepare pupils for joining the Passport to Adventure in years 7 & 8 and then the Duke of Edinburgh Award in years 9, 10 & 11. **Please sign up below.**

The second week, week commencing Monday 2nd August, we will be running a three day summer school focusing on the Creative Arts. This will involve music, drama, singing and art. This is open to everyone in year 6 who will be joining us in year 7 and we would like to see as many pupils as possible. Pupils will be encouraged to sign up for the school production at Christmas, which will be Peter Pan, as well as signing up for peripatetic music lessons in September. The 2nd Aug will be a Musical Theatre Day - Singing, Dancing and Acting; 3rd August - Singer Song Writer Day including Piano sessions; 4th August - Music Instrument Day - Learning how to play Wind and brass instruments with a Samba Drumming Session in the afternoon. **Please sign up below.**

Week beginning 2.8.2021 and also 9.8.2021 we will be running additional catch up summer schools, focussing on literacy, numeracy, and creativity. This will be run by staff from Corringham Primary School at Hassenbrook Academy and will focus on plugging the gaps missed due to lockdown. **Please sign up below.**

Finally on the **27th July and 10th August**, Fusion netball academy will be running netball training for year 6s from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. **Sign up details will be emailed to you.**

Practical arrangements

For all summer schools, the day will run from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m.; lunch will be provided and pupils will need to wear appropriate clothing (not school uniform) as they will be doing practical activities as well as being in the classroom. More details will be provided to those that sign up nearer the time.


